Trunk or Treat



Iowa Assessments-April 1-5

These Assessments will be given during the week of **April 1-5**. These assessments are aligned to the Iowa Core and Common Core Standards. All Saints uses the Iowa Assessments as ONE measurement in our comprehensive view of our students and school. Grades 3-8 will take the Iowa Assessments. These tests provide a comprehensive and continuous measurement of growth in the fundamental skills: vocabulary, reading, mathematics, mechanics of writing, and methods of study. We should receive the results later this year and the results will be sent home with information to help parents understand their son of daughter's scores.
